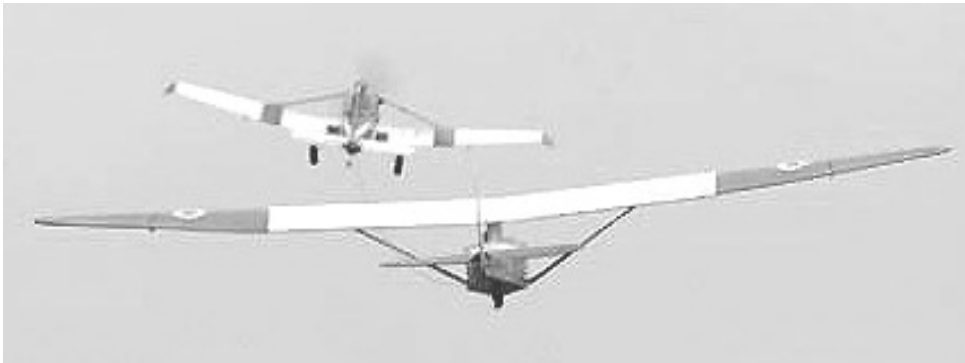


Aerotowing Day

Models from 1.5 to 6m span can be towed**

There will be a number of tugs available to get you in the air.

A briefing will be held at 09:30am before flying starts.

The field is next to the New England Highway, roughly 12 Km south of Toowoomba's Kmart. Travelling south, the site lies on the right of the highway, is nestled between two hills just past the Hodgson Vale Rural Supplies and quarry.

Club facilities are readily sighted from the road.

Please note: If you haven't attempted Aerotow before, your model MUST have a functioning transmitter controlled tow release fitted near the nose. One of the organisers will make the determination whether the model is suitable for towing or not.
